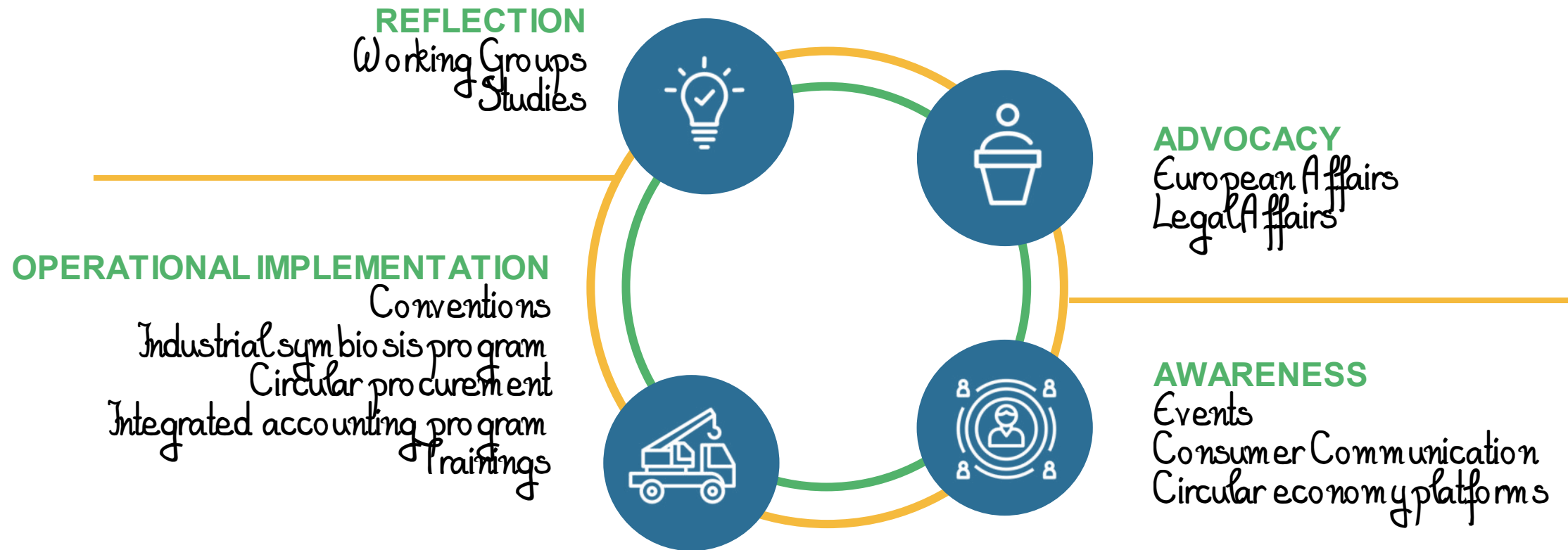

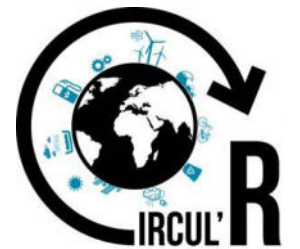
The actions of the Institute are mainly articulated around 4 axes: reflection, advocacy, implementation and circular economy awareness.

Impact on regulation and reforms : The France's example

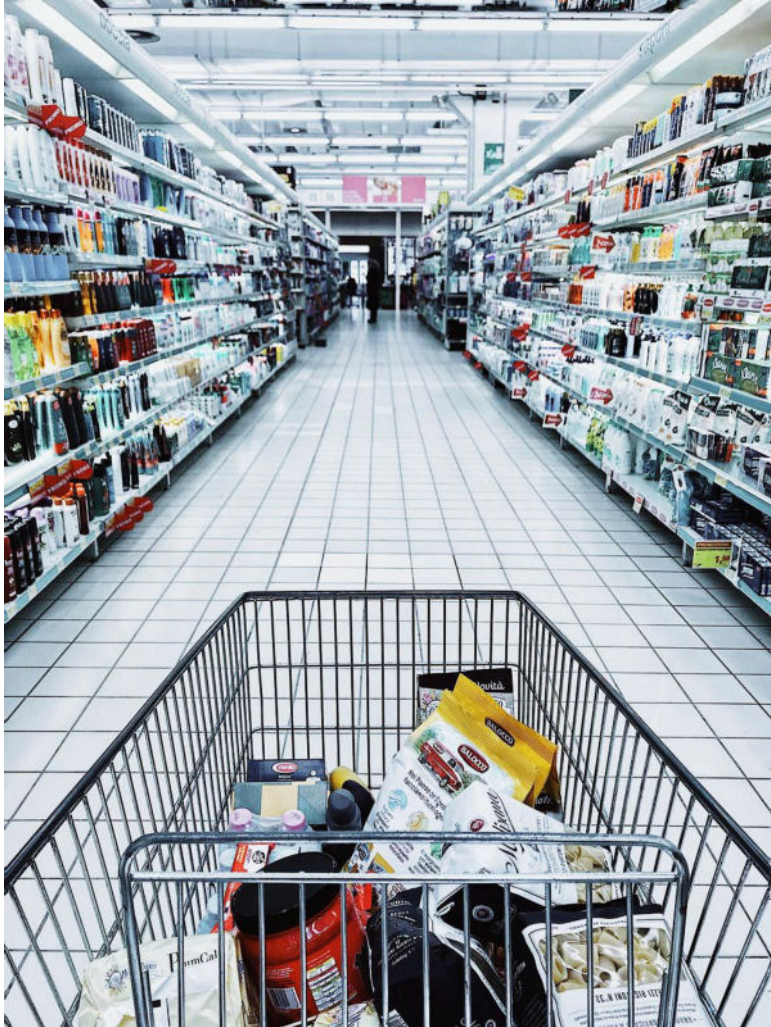


- ⇒ Circular Economy Roadmap, April 2018
- ⇒ Law on fight against waste and the circular economy, February 2020



- Getting out of disposable plastic (2040)
- Better inform consumers
- Fight against waste (banning) and for solidarity-based reuse
- Extended producer responsibility scale reform
- A controversial deposit-return system

⇒ To be continued : implementation decrees, Recovery plan and Finance Act for 2021, Climate law 2021



Reinforcement of producers' consumer information obligations

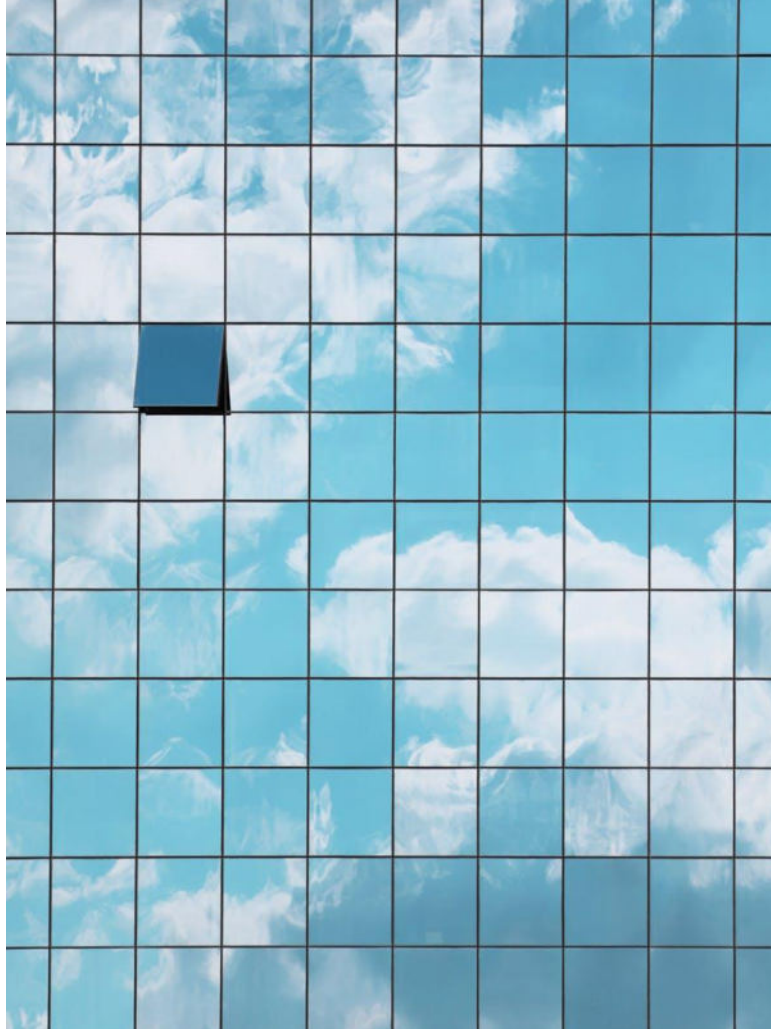
- Creation of a reparability index from 2021 and a sustainability index from 2024
- Obligation to provide information on the availability of spare parts
- Obligation to affix a sign on the rules for sorting products
- Obligation to provide information on the presence of endocrine disruptors in products

END OF DISPOSABLE PLASTIC



End of disposable plastic in 2040 and other objectives

- Registration of the end of placing on the market of single use plastic packaging by 2040
- Aim to "move towards" 100% recycled plastic by 2025
- Creation by 2021 of a reuse and re-use observatory
- Prohibition of the provision of a series of single-use plastic products



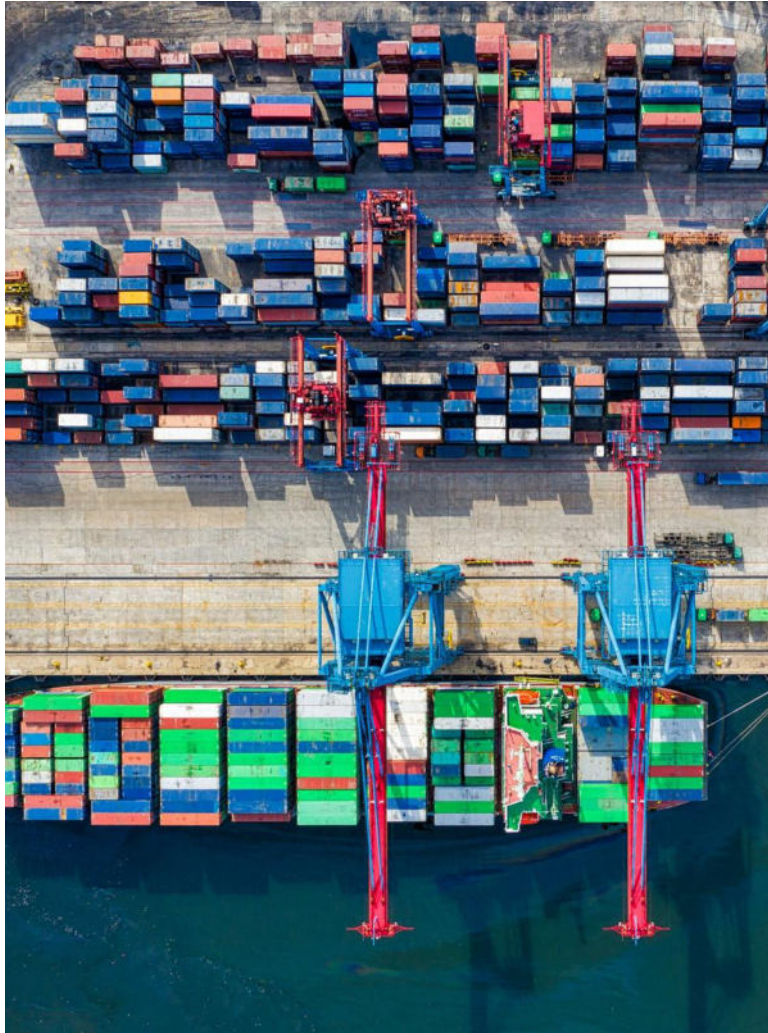
Towards a circular public procurement

- Promote goods that are reused, repaired or that incorporate recycled materials (20% to 100% depending on the product)
- Possibilities of using donations for public persons to prevent waste generation

The missing component of buyer support:

- Availability of LCA tools / circular economy criteria and standard clauses

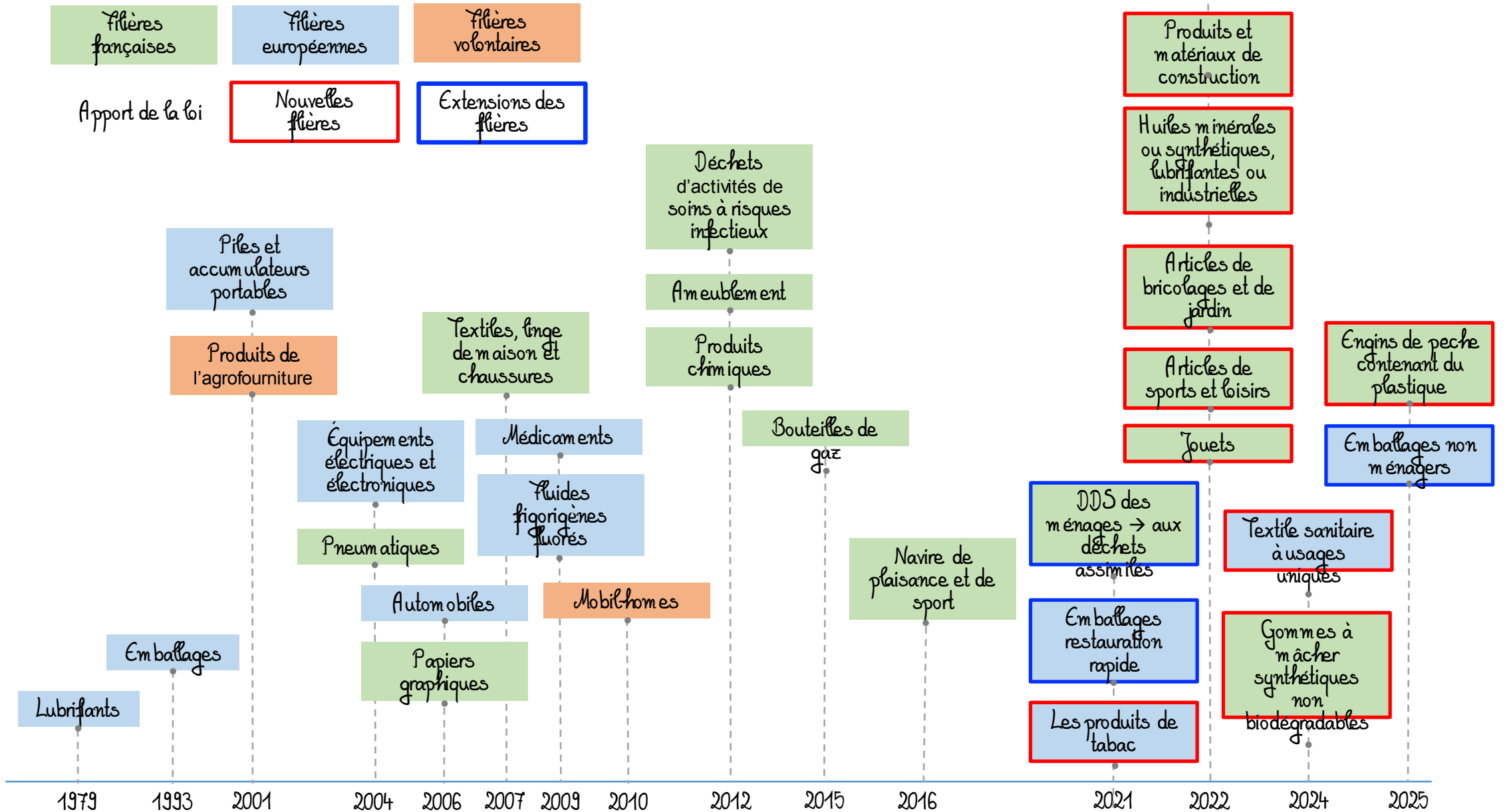
EXTENDED PRODUCER RESPONSIBILITY



Important reforms in Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR)

- Extension of the missions of the REP sectors
- Modulation of eco-contributions in the form of a bonus-malus, based on environmental performance criteria
- Creation of a fund dedicated to the financing of repair, and a fund dedicated to the financing of reuse and re-use
- Creation of a "Stakeholder Committee" by eco-organizations
- Creation of new PWR sectors and extension of existing ones
