The Municipality of Tinos, organizes a raising awareness event entitled: “Circular Economy in the Cyclades – The case of Tinos” on Monday 11 October, 18:00-20:00, at the House of Culture and Education of the Municipality of Tinos (Moschoulis School).

The Municipality of Tinos, participates in the European project LIFE-IP CEI-Greece “Circular Economy Implementation in Greece” coordinated by the Ministry of the Environment and Energy, in cooperation with 18 strategic partners. In the context of this project, Tinos has been selected as one of the pilot areas to operate as a prime example for the implementation of the National Waste Management Plan, the National Waste Prevention Plan and the National Circular Economy Strategy.

The LIFE-IP CEI-Greece project aims to develop and operate an integrated waste management system at the island of Tinos, for the application of the EU Circular Economy legal framework.
