Report on the interim evaluation of the e-course and webinar material

July, 2026





Executive Summary

This deliverable presents the results of the interim evaluation of the training material of the e-courses and webinars, which was developed for the E-learning program for Circular Economy, within the framework of Sub-action C7.3 Distance Training for stakeholders.

Initially, a brief description of the training program is provided. The program was implemented from October 2025 to June 2026 through three training cycles, each targeting a specific stakeholder group: 1) Local Government, 2) Tourism professionals, and 3) Educators.

The evaluation of the e-learning program and the training material developed for the online courses and webinars is then presented. In particular, participation indicators are analysed for each training cycle, including the number of applicants, participants and those who successfully completed the program. Overall, the program attracted more than 1.000 participants from across Greece, confirming the wide reach of the action and the strong interest in developing knowledge and skills related to the Circular Economy.

Finally, the results of the participants' evaluation of the program are analysed, based on an online questionnaire completed by a total of 327 participants across the three training cycles. The results indicate a particularly high level of satisfaction with the quality and clarity of the training content, the organisation and structure of the program, as well as the trainers' expertise and ability to effectively communicate the subject matter. Participants also recognised the usefulness of the knowledge and tools presented for their professional activities, particularly in terms of their practical application.

The results of the interim evaluation of the training material developed for the online courses and webinars confirm the effectiveness of the program and the achievement of its educational objectives, while the participants' feedback provides useful guidance for the further enhancement and improvement of the training material.
